CAMPAIGN

The diocesan finance committee and the Chancery board, have notified us at Clergy Days, that we need to replace our present Chancery Office Building in New Chancery in New Ulm. . The construction back in the 50's was shoddy, and all pipes carrying water, heat and air conditioning and electrical work, were laid into the foundation and cement walls as it was being poured which makes repair difficult, costly and sometimes almost impossible. They are proposing a 12 million dollar campaign, to removed the present building and replace it with a new building further down the street.

They have employed 2 deacons from Winona for fund raising and one of them will be at Appleton, Catholic Church on Nov. 12, 7 p.m. to see how desirable this project is amongst the people of the diocese. THE DIOCESAN MINISTRIES APPEAL 2008-2009, is drawing to a close. Not one of the 3 parishes reached their goal. Presently St. John's of Ortonville owes \$3,150.90. St. Joseph of Rosen owes \$1,245.69 and St. James of Nassau owes \$738.70. They doubled next years quota for Rosen to \$4,541.38, because the Rosen parishioners increased the number of envelope holders, who give more than 50 dollars a year. If all contributions toward the Ministry Appeal stop at this point, it will mean that we will have to use our savings to complete the above numbers in all three parishes. Please help us out.
